Paula Cooper, former director of Park Place Gallery announces the opening of a large new loft gallery at 96-100 Prince Street, New York (one block south of Houston Street and one block west of Broadway).

Much current painting and sculpture is unsuited by intent and size to intimate indoor space. The opening of this spacious 5,000 square foot loft as an exhibition space is a move toward bridging the gap between usual gallery context and artists' increasingly public orientation.

Emphasis is on large outdoor painting and sculpture and there is a special area for the exhibition of drawings and models for commission. Photographs and slides of existing outdoor pieces will also be available.

To allow more flexibility, exhibits will evolve with the changing of individual works and not be presented on a monthly basis.

The space will also be used for special events by artists in other media, (i.e.: concerts, readings, films etc.)
